## DARKNESS INTO LIGHT 20 YEARS OF THE PAN AM FLIGHT 103 ARCHIVES

The Pan Am Flight 103/Lockerbie Air Disaster Archives at Syracuse University was established in 1990 to house records relating to Pan Am Flight 103, destroyed by a terrorist bomb over Lockerbie, Scotland on December 21, 1988, killing 270 men, women, and children. 35 students studying abroad with Syracuse University were killed in the attack. The tragedy is known internationally as the Lockerbie Air Disaster.

The goal of the Archives is to bring together in one place materials generated regarding the disaster; make those materials available for research; and provide a place to personalize those whose lives were lost. Included are records not only of Syracuse University and our students, but records of ALL 270 victims and other involved individuals and organizations.
